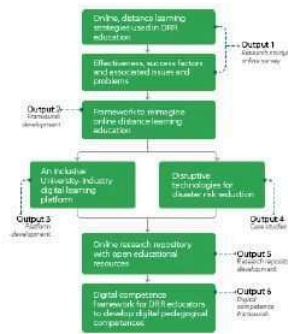

Background

INCLUDE (INCLUSIVE Disaster Education) is a collaborative research project co-funded by EU Erasmus+ programme. This two-year research initiative aims to reimagine online distance learning education so that it better supports the diverse DRR community.

The COVID-19 pandemic is defining global health crisis of our time and the greatest challenge for the world since World War II. As a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the education sector has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms. Due to the complexities involved in and due to the peculiar nature of disaster situations, even before COVID-19, there were consensus among researchers that lifelong learning is an appropriate way of ensuring continuous education to the various stakeholders of disaster management. To support lifelong learning, a number of online, distance learning opportunities emerged in the field of DRR in the recent past. As such, many countries have launched remote DRR education activities, however, these opportunities pose many challenges. To tackle these challenges, INCLUDE will develop a University-Industry digital learning platform to provide high quality inclusive digital education in DRR.
